

Admission Requirement for International Students In Masters' and Doctorate Programs

Required Documents

1. Standard Admissions Forms in English (1 each)

- Admissions Application
- Letter of Spiritual Life and Calling
- Interview Papers
- Recommendation Letter from Applicant's Pastor/Minister (Must be sealed)
- Graduation Certificate or Date of Graduation
- Official Transcript
- Certificate of Graduation from Berea Academy
- Certificate of Baptism or Copy
- Two Photos

*All forms must be notarized by the Apostille. If your country is not a member

of the Apostille, then have local embassy of your country notarized it or get a approval letter of approved out-of-state education facility.

2. Students taking courses in Korean

Copy of Result of Standardized Korean Test (TOPIK)
(Applicants with **TOPIK Level 3** or above are allowed to take classes in Korean)

3. Students taking courses in English

Copy of Result of Standardized English Test
-TOEFL-PBT 550, TOEFL-iBT 80, TEPS 550, FLEX 550 or higher taken within the last two years will be accepted
-People from English speaking countries (US, Canada, UK, Australia, South Africa, Etc) with a Bachelor's Degree are exempt from this rule.
-People from non-English speaking countries with a Bachelor's Degree or above from English speaking countries are exempt from this rule.

4. The Applicant's or Finance guarantor's bank balance proof exceeding **\$20,000 US**

(deposited for longer than one month) ^{SEP}or A Proof of transfer to Korea or currency exchange of an amount over **\$20,000 US**.

5. Finance guarantor's

- Proof of employment or business registration certificate: One copy
- A Copy of Income tax payment proof
- A Copy of an agreement to pay the applicant's education expenses

6. Proof of Church Membership

7. Copy of Passport or Alien Registration Card

However, an Applicant recommended by the 21st Century Mission Berea Seoul Sungrak Church will have to go through additional admission requirements.
